Fee of \$28.00 first entry / Fee of \$18.00 2nd/3rd & 4th entry of same dog (per day)

(All fees include AKC recording fees)

Entries will be accepted in paper form and OLE (max100/day) overnight entries MUST have the signature requirement waived.

Entry fees are reduced by 50% for Junior Handlers who are under 18 at time of trial, possess an AKC Junior Number, and are running a dog owned by self or immediate family member.

TRIAL HOURS

All days: The trial hours are 7:30 a.m. to 30 minutes after completion of judging. Judging will start at 9am.

WAIT LIST

SHCA will offer a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 25 dogs per day will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 p.m. September 25, 2024. Any entries withdrawn prior to that time will be replaced by a wait list entry when available. A full refund will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. **Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 5:00 p.m. October 2, 2024, will receive a full refund.**

COURSE SIZE AND SURFACE

The ring is indoors on astroturf. The course size is approximately 100' x 110' feet.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION & WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the Judge's Briefing.

A warm-up area consisting of a single regulation agility jump will be provided.

MOVE-UPS

Dogs may be moved to a higher class only at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, **no later than 6:00 p.m. October 10, 2024, to be effective for the first day of the Trial. Move ups from the LPDTC trial in Fort Collins that weekend will be honored. Please submit within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the class you are moving from at the LPDTC trial.**

For Titles earned during this trial, a move up form must be delivered to the Trial Secretary ASAP of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from for the subsequent trial. Dogs so moved will be entered at the end of the running order. **Move-ups forms will be available at the trial to be filled out and given to the Trial Secretary.** A move-up email will not be official unless acknowledged by the secretary.

Class Changes effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day:

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then **NO Double Q** shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights on the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day. **A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights on the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.**

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL

Progressive School for Dogs is located between Greeley and Loveland.

- From I-25 north or south take exit #257 (US34) east
- Continue east on US34 approximately 6 miles to CO 257 (Windsor/Milliken exit)
- Head north on CO 257 approximately 0.6 mile toward Windsor
- Take first driveway on your right
- From Greeley, take US 34 west to CO 257 and follow directions above
- From Loveland take US34 east to CO 257 and follow directions above

Airport: Denver International Airport is the closest large airport to the site (about 1 hour away).

JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

Starting Jan.1, 2001, all dogs that do not have a permanent or valid temporary Jump Height Card issued by the AKC shall be measured by a judge of record prior to competing. Please have your Jump Height card with you at the trial. Measuring of dogs without cards must take place prior to their first class.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any Trial. In traditional agility, dogs may, at the handler's option, be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in Preferred must run in the division appropriate to their height. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Members of SHCA, Progressive School for Dogs (Liz Blasio), their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

SHCA may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against SHCA or any official thereof.

The safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the Rules & Regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entries must reach the Trial Secretary by 6:00 p.m. September 25th, 2024, or when 100 runs per trial have been reached. Fees must accompany all entries. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms. Postdated checks and returned checks will invalidate an entry. There will be a \$25 Service Fee charged for returned checks. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season are not allowed at the Trial. Entry fees for bitches that come into season before the Trial will be refunded, less \$10.00 per trial for the Judge and Secretary, provided the Trial Secretary is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. Unsigned entries cannot be accepted nor will telephoned entries be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules are not acceptable. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions for its acceptance. **Neither the Club nor the Trial Secretary are responsible for legibility or accuracy of contact information provided on completed forms, technical difficulties in electronic communications, or postal delays. It is therefore recommended that handlers email the Trial Secretary 7 to 10 days from mailing their entry to confirm receipt.**

ONLINE ENTRIES: Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your My AKC account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 100 online entries and 25 paper entries each trial. If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by phone are not acceptable.

For single copies of the Regulations for Agility Trials, write to the AKC, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390 or e-mail info@akc.org. This trial will be conducted in accordance with the Regulations for Agility Trials, effective Jan. 1, 2022.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

This trial is open to Siberian Huskies over the age of 15 months that are registered with the AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration & Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for being ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. SHCA and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for locating dogs that are not at ringside when required.

At the handler's option, dogs may wear flat buckle or quick snap collars, but there shall be no hanging tags or attachments. Choke, pinch, electric, or dummy collars are prohibited.

All dogs must be always on leash and in control at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s), children, and guest(s). Any exhibitor whose dog(s), children, or guest(s) create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

All regulations governing the use of this facility and all regulations and decisions of the SHCA Trial Committee on these days will be strictly enforced.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and parking areas. Dogs may be exercised ONLY in designated areas. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs **AT ALL TIMES**. No dogs are allowed overnight at the Trial site.

Entries overpaid by \$10 or less will not be issued a refund.

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

FEO will be offered at this trial!

Below are the two Standing Rules for agility trials at the SHCA National Specialty:

There will be a HIT each trial and one overall combining both trials

1. Agility H.I.T. will be awarded from the Standard Class, including Regular and Preferred, to the Highest Scoring Siberian. (4-27-03)
2. In the Agility Trial, in the case of a tie in score then seconds under course time weighted as follows will be used to determine HIT. Using the following calculations HIT would go to the Siberian with the highest number:
 Novice Preferred Standard: Seconds under course time is multiplied by 1
 Open Preferred Standard: Seconds under course time is multiplied by 2
 Excellent Preferred Standard: Seconds under course time is multiplied by 3
 Novice Standard: Seconds under course time is multiplied by 2 with 5 points added
 Open Standard: Seconds under course time is multiplied by 3 with 5 points added
 Excellent Standard: Seconds under course time is multiplied by 4 with 5 points added. (4-27-03)
 The largest calculated Standard Course Time (SCT) will be used when comparing dogs jumping different heights who have competed against each other in a class at the same level of skill. (2020/013)

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number where indicated on the official entry form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the AKC (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, indicate below the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner.
